VIOLATIONS **Deed Restrictio**

Did you know these facts about deed restrictions? Provided by Mike Brady.

- 1. Trash cans must be stored out of sight from the street
- 2. Cars must be parked the direction of traffic and within 18" of the curb.
- 3. Do not park on your lawn.
- 4. No commercial vehicles are to be parked on your property.
- 5. Sidewalks should never be blocked.



6. All improvements to your property must be approved by the architecture committee. Forms are available through the property owner's portal.



7. All fences are to be cedar picket construction and a rot board at the base of the pickets.
